General FAQs for 1st Year B. Arch Admissions 2020-21

Q.1. Is National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) Mandatory for securing admission into Architecture?

Ans: NATA/JEE 2 (B.Arch.) is mandatory to pursue Architecture Course. NATA is conducted by the Council of Architecture at national level for admission to 5 year B. Arch Degree Course at all recognized institutions across India. NATA/JEE 2 scores are used by admissions authorities of different State Governments.

Q.2 Do class 12th marks matter in securing admission to Architecture?

Ans: All the colleges consider your 12th class marks for admission into B.Arch., with 50 - 50 weightage system (50% of NATA/JEE 2 exam score, 50% of XII (12th) class, board exam aggregate score with physics, chemistry and maths as subjects for 12th Class)

Q.3 What are the NATA/JEE 2 exam dates?

Ans: The First Test and Second Test of NATA 2020 shall be conducted on 1st August 2020 and 29th August 2020 respectively. The authorities will also re-open the NATA registration for both tests along with the correction window soon. Kindly refer (<http://www.nata.in/>).

Q.4. How many parts or sections will be there in NATA examinations?

Ans : There are two sections, Part A & B, Part A (total 125 marks) is on Drawing, which is paper based and Part B (75 marks) comprises of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) on Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and general aptitude which is to be answered online.

Q.5. What is the Syllabus of NATA examination?

Ans: NATA syllabus 2020 consists of all the topics of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, General Aptitude, and Drawing from which the question papers will be prepared.

Q.6. What are the Cut off marks for NATA examination?

Ans: The Cut off marks for NATA examination are that, the candidate must secure an aggregate of 25% marks in Part A and 25% marks in Part B. The overall qualifying marks for NATA examinations will be based on post exams statistics and as per the decision of the Council of Architecture.

Q.7. What is the score required for JEE main in Architecture?

Ans: The score required is 'non zero' positive score in JEE paper 2.

Q.8. What is the admission procedure at the Rizvi College of Architecture after NATA / JEE examination?

Ans: Candidate has to apply 'ONLINE' at DTE, State Common Entrance Test Cell (www.mahacet.org) Government of Maharashtra for admission on the basis of NATA score or JEE Score. DTE code of Rizvi college of Architecture, Mumbai is **DT3246**

Q.9.What is the admission eligibility after NATA?

Ans: - (i) The Candidate should be an Indian National.

(ii) Passed HSC or its equivalent with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also at least 50% marks in aggregate (at least 45% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and also at least 45% marks in aggregate in case of candidates of Reserved class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra state only) or as declared by appropriate authority, from time to time.

OR

(ii) Passed (10+3) Full time Diploma examination recognized by All India Council for Technical Education or Central or State Government or its equivalent examination and obtained at least 50% marks in aggregate (at least 45% marks in aggregate in case of candidates of Reserved class categories and Persons with Disability belonging to Maharashtra state only) with Mathematics as compulsory subject or as declared by the Appropriate Authority, from time to time.

(iii) The Candidate should have obtained qualifying marks in NATA or obtained Non Zero Positive Score in JEE (Main) Paper II.

(iv) Any other criterion declared from time to time by the appropriate authority as defined under the Act.

Q.10 How many seats are there in Rizvi College of Architecture for B.Arch?

Ans: - We are having total 80 seats for B.Arch. Out of that 41 seats are reserved for Muslim minority. 23 seats are for open category. For both this seats the admission is done through cap round. There are 16 seats reserved for admissions at institute level. For this the admission is done at College with prior DTE verification of documents.

Q.11 What is the general admission procedure for B.Arch.?

Ans:- To participate in Centralised Admission Process (CAP), the eligible candidates have to fill Online Application Form for CAP. The candidate can also fill the online application form via Facilitation Centre. The Centre will facilitate the candidate in complete CAP Application Process ranging from filling the Online Application Form, scanning the documents to uploading the required documents without any charges.

The candidates can also fill the Online Application Form themselves and upload the scanned copies of the required documents through any computer connected to the internet.

After filling the application form candidate will have to personally visit the Facilitation Centre for Confirmation of Online Application Form and Document Verification.
